The exhibition invites visitors to explore the connections between Romantic and contemporary ideas of the forest - especially against the backdrop of current ecological crises. Jointly organized by three museums - the Deutsches Romantik-Museum, the Senckenberg Naturmuseum Frankfurt and the Museum Sinclair-Haus - the exhibition offers an interdisciplinary journey of discovery through the forests of the past, present and future.
