WEISS WAR DER SCHNEE (White was the Snow)

The exhibition "WEISS WAR DER SCHNEE (White was the Snow)" will open at the Fuhrwerkswaage on 20 March 2026 at 6 pm, presenting photographs by Thomas Wrede that document the retreat of Alpine glaciers. The display is enhanced by a 16-metre-wide panorama from the MOUNTAINVIEW Gallery.

At the opening, the artist and geoscientist Dr André Baumeister will give talks, providing insights into glaciers as climatic archives and discussing the implications of their ongoing retreat. The exhibition combines artistic and scientific perspectives, highlighting the subtle yet irreversible transformations affecting these fragile environments.
